A FEW FACTS ABOUT MORRIS (OR CANEY)

The crossroads now called Morris is usually called Caney by local folks.

John and Margaret Hicks deeded five acres in 1883 to the Caney Methodist church. Several years later church services were on alternate Sundays with the Baptists. When the Methodist congregation dwindled, the Methodists deeded it to the Baptists and it became the Morris Missionary Baptist Church. Vester Tucker and his son, Loyce Tucker also deeded land for the expansion of the Caney Cemetery in later years.

The oldest Morris grave at Caney is that of W. Ephram Morris (1846-1916), a Civil War veteran. Was Morris named after him? That question has not been answered.

There was a school at Caney in the early 1900s as well as two churches (the Baptist and Nazarene).

Hwy. 299 leading from Bluff City to Morris was called Clark Road on the 1865 map. Hwy. 200 toward Cale was called McLean's Mill Road in 1865.

Probably the earliest marked grave at Caney Cemetery is that of Sarah Townsend Davis, wife of A. J. Davis, who died in November 15, 1877. The grave is a tomb-like sepulcher made from brick or rocks with the name and dates on one end.

The second oldest marked grave is that of Elizabeth Munn who died in August 9, 1878.

There are only seven marked graves with death dates before 1900:
